In international policy, he tried to emulate his uncle, with numerous Imperial ventures around the world, as well as wars in Europe. In the face of the insurrection that had now taken possession of the whole capital, King Louis-Philippe abdicated in favour of his grandson, Prince Philippe, Count of Paris claimed by Alphonse de Lamartine in the name of the provisional government elected by the Chamber under the pressure of the mob.
